

Configuring IHEID_AUTH on Android

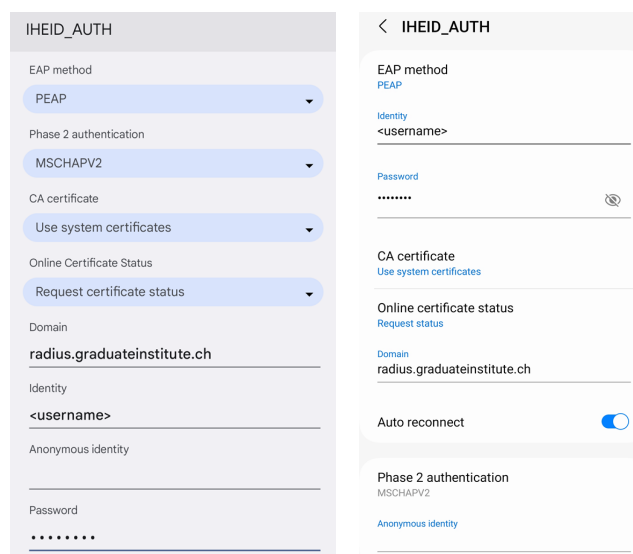
1. General

The procedure describes the steps required to configure the **IHEID_AUTH Wi-Fi network** on a personal Android device.

2. Configuration

To configure and connect to the IHEID_AUTH Wi-Fi network¹:

1. Open your device's Settings App.
2. Tap **Network & internet** and then **Internet**, or tap **Connections** and then **Wi-Fi**. Alternatively, search for **Wi-Fi** in the Settings App search field.
3. Tap on **IHEID_AUTH** in the list of available networks.
4. Select the following options:
 - EAP Method: **PEAP**
 - Phase 2 authentication: **MSCHAPV2**
 - CA certificate: **Use system certificates**
 - Online Certificate Status: **Request certificate status / Request status**
 - Domain: **radius.graduateinstitute.ch**
 - Identity: your IT login
 - Password: your IT login password
5. Tap on **Connect** to save your configuration and connect to the network.
